In April of 2020, Winco manufactured and delivered 21 of our 1150S Series windows fitted with hurricane laminated E-missile glass to the Louisiana Pump Station in Tampa as part of a major building rehab that included replacement of pumps, new generators, flooring, roofing, windows, electrical and HVAC updates, and more.

The potential threat of high-velocity winds due to hurricanes, tornados, or severe storms necessitated that the Louisiana Pump Station replace its older windows with ones featuring solid framing and hurricane-resistant glazing. Winco's 1150S series fit the bill nicely.

With multiple windows in varying sizes on all sides, employees can keep a watchful eye on the sky when heavy rains are forecast. After back-to-back storms with Hurricane Helene and Hurricane Milton in 2024, Winco's specially reinforced 1150S windows passed the test!
