The historic structure was also used in the filming of the 1993 classic film, Rudy, a biographical movie about playing football at the University.

By 2024, the building was ready for a refresh. The single-paned aluminum windows were cold and drafty in the winter and let in the heat during the hot Midwest summers. St. Louis-based Mackey Mitchell architects worked with Winco to restore the building's aesthetics and deliver much needed energy efficiency. A combination of Winco's easy-to-operate 3410 series horizontal slider windows and 1450 series windows were used to accomplish both goals.
